Special Operations Unit Crime Suppression Detail Results

On June 12, 2026, the Columbus Police Department's Special Operations Unit conducted a crime suppression detail focused on proactive enforcement and addressing criminal activity throughout the city. During the detail, officers made contact with 311 individuals, conducted 221 traffic stops, issued 116 citations, and made 26 arrests.

As a result of enforcement efforts, officers seized:

- 147.9 grams of marijuana
- 2 firearms (both reported stolen)
- 20 miscellaneous pills
- Drug-related objects
- \$9,274 in U.S. currency

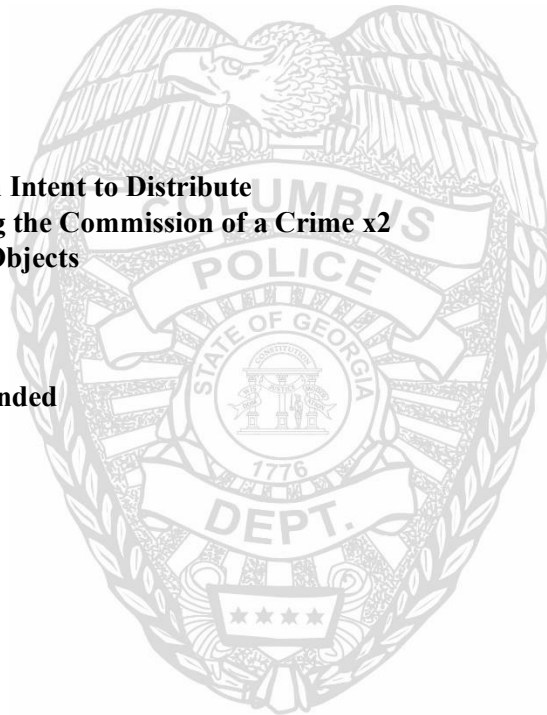

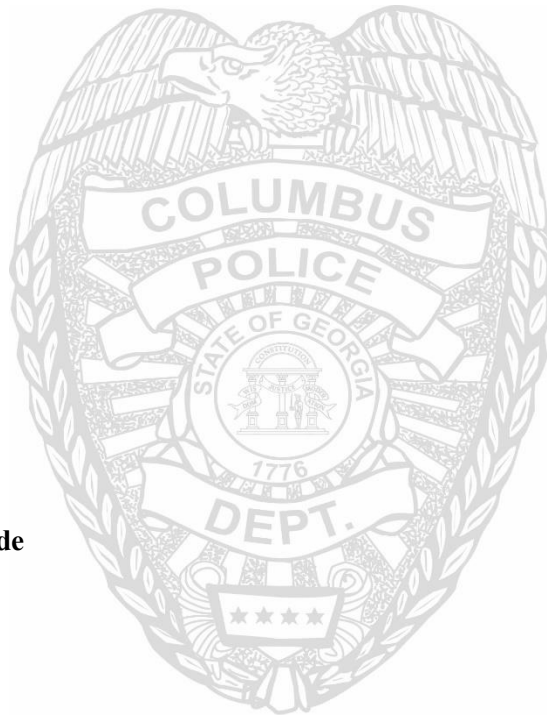
